

The Crossroads Chapel has undergone many changes and we are excited to share with you just what has transpired. First, the Chapel is fully carpeted front to back. We installed a new kitchen floor that will uphold the worst water leaks and new lockers that will help keep volunteers' belongings safe and secure.

The building has gone through some changes and so has the ministry. In 2020 the Crossroads Board voted to expand our horizons. A "365" committee was formed and is made up of 4 individuals from the Board: Larry Kutzler, Chris Heeb, Terry Schuveiller, and Shawn Jones. This group's mission is to bring the ministry outside the walls

The DIAGNOSIS and the CURE



I told you have an undetected spiritual cancer, which is tormenting your soul and killing your body, would you want the cure? Would the cure be good news? Maybe only if you first received the bad news.

It is only by the work of Jesus that we can be saved. Our own work can never be good enough to inherit righteousness. (Eph 2:8-9)

Then Jesus offered us a cure for the sin problem. This cure He said is a free gift and available for anyone to accept or reject. The gift is that if we confess Jesus as Lord, believe in his substitutional death for our sins, and that the Lord raised him from the dead we will have our sins forgiven and will live forever with Him in paradise. (Rom 10:9-11, Psalm 23:6 Luke 23:43)

t was the 135th anniversary of the St. Paul Winter Carnival, and it was sure to be special. How little we knew just how extraordinary it would be! There would be no parades, no gathering, and surely, masks would be required. The Vulcans had a conundrum on their hands. Combined with determination to hold the annual Vulcan Snow Park, and seeing the success of other drive-thru events during a pandemic, the Vulcan organization teamed up with the Saint Paul Winter Carnival to create the "Winter Carnival Drive-Thru Ice and Snow Sculpture Park."

With the generous help of Crossroads Chapel and the much appreciated donation of their heated haven, the Vulcans were able to pull off one of the most successful Vulcan Snow Parks yet! A combined total of 36 sculptures

were erected along the route, and over 15.000 cars loaded up with families and friends drove through the carefully planned route. The most incredible part, however, was the generosity of those that drove through. Over six tons of food was collected for Second Harvest Heartland. and over \$13,000.00 were raised. Of that, \$5000.00 was leveraged at a three to one match, making the final amount donated to Second Harvest Heartland over \$28,000.00!

It was a difficult year for many, a struggle to distance ourselves from our friends and families. Life changed in ways none of us could imagine, but difficult times allow mankind's generosity to shine.

hen Ruby* received a private message on social media offering her a job at a computer shop, she saw it as a way to begin a life of independence. She quickly discovered the job wasn't what she was offered.

Instead, she was trapped in the grasp of a couple who exploited her in front of strangers online who would pay for her abuse.

She was 16.

"I felt imprisoned and powerless. I cried and prayed... 'Lord, if you're real, get me out of here!" Ruby recalls.


International Justice Mission (IJM) helped local authorities find and rescue her along with 5 other girls. The people who ran the illegal operation were sentenced to 15 years in prison.

Today, Ruby is free and safe. She has even forgiven the couple who harmed her - praying for them at the back of the courtroom after their conviction.

IJM worked to place Ruby in an aftercare home where she lives as she studies in college. She is considering pursuing a law degree with the hope of helping other girls who are trapped in similar trafficking operations.

Ruby has a new life because people prayed and gave to the work of freedom. Will you join us?



was born and raised in a affluent conservative Muslim family in Southwest Asia. Praying 5 times a day was not forced upon anyone but was encouraged and neither did women have to cover their heads with Hijabs. We lived and ate in a very "western way" but followed the 5 pillars of Islam. I am the oldest of 3 children and only daughter. I was born in one of the only Christian Hospitals still standing in my birth country.

While I was going to college Minnesota as an international student, I converted to Chrisitianity on

Feb. 22, 1998 at the age of 21. I kept my conversion a secret from my family for 2 1/2 years for fear that my Muslim father would kill me per Islamic laws. I was told I can never talk to Christians again because I was putting the family in danger. Years of torture left me broken but Jesus had plans that led me to choose Him over my family.


Meeting Rebekah changed

me. As I sat and listened to her story unfold, I was in awe of her love for Christ and her obedience and willingness to lay down all that she was for all that He is. As I choked back tears, I found myself seeing some of my favorite scriptures coming alive before my very eyes. Phillipians 3:8-10 "What is more, I consider everything a loss compared to the surpassing greatness of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things. I consider them

rubbish, that I may gain Christ and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes

from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ-- the righteousness that comes from God and is by faith. I want to know Christ and the power of his resurrection and the fellowship of sharing in his sufferings, becoming like him in his death, and so, somehow, to attain the resurrection from the dead." As she spoke, this scripture captured her life. Rebekah's story is an example of coming to a place where nothing else will satisfy but Jesus himself. It is a journey that can only be accomplished when we give all that we are for all that he is.

This book is significant. It is a book that expands our understanding of what many have endured and few have had an opportunity to share. It is a book of choices. An example of choosing the road less traveled for a greater reward. It is a book of hope that is shown in the story of our redemption that can only be found in Jesus. When we die to our old nature, it is then we truly live...



Rebekah's heart behind this memoir has always been to present her story as one written by the Lord. She laid down her life long ago trusting that in doing so, the Lord would instruct her tongue and footsteps to glorify Him and give others hope. She offers that same chance and choice to you today. If you do not know Christ as your personal savior, today is the day of salvation. 2 Corinthians 6:2 "For he says, 'In the time of my favor I heard you, and in the day of salvation I helped you.' My Time for Freedom,

by Luca Jo Groppoli

y story isn't new, nor am I the only one. Listen to understand how I became a transgender male then found complete redemption and restoration in Jesus. Childhood trauma led me down the road to being transgender. My mother died when I was 6.

Nobody told me where she went. At 10, I was sexually molested by several people, including a family member. This resulted in dissociative disorder, a mental disorder causing a disconnection among thoughts, memories, surroundings, actions, and identity. People with dissociative disorders escape reality in ways that are involuntary and unhealthy, causing problems in everyday life.

I felt betrayed by family, who hadn't protected me, and then I even felt betrayed by my own body and mind.

One day while doing the laundry I noticed my brother's shirt and tried it on. I saw myself in the mirror and looked different—boyish, strong, I had come into agreement with a liethat being a girl meant I'd be a victim, but being a male meant being an abuser. I didn't wish to be victimized, and seeing myself in men's clothes, I suddenly didn't see myself as the victim. Why would I NOT want to feel safe, hiding my true identity? I learned to present myself as a male. I did it for years before my family realized I needed help.

They did what they thought was best, taking me to the Program in Human Sexuality through the University of Minnesota where I took several psychological tests. Their conclusion? Gender Dysphoria. They explained it was a mix-up before I was born: my hormones and chromosomes didn't match: one indicated I was male. the other: female.



Huh. Made sense. "What can I do about it?" Their advice: a sex change. Seemed like a good option, as I hated being myself. After living as male for several years, I qualified for hormone treatment, but I never went any further as something kept me from it. But I lived as a man for over 3 decades.

In my forties, I met a woman, and we decided to live together. Her stipulation was that I go to church and a weekly Bible study. "Wait, you're a lesbian, and you want me to go to church?

They hate us!" Nonetheless I went because I wanted to keep the girl.

The first time I went, the pastor had an alter call. I went forwardsomething pulled me like a magnet. After being prayed for, I fell to the floor and wept. Afterward, it felt as though someone had taken a backpack off me; that was my selfhatred falling away.

Two weeks later, the pastor and his wife took me to lunch. They explained that I was living separated from God and that sin leads us to hell. Well, let me tell you, I didn't like hearing that

AT ALL! But suddenly it felt like all the lies I'd been told at the Program in Human Sexuality came crumbling

down. I never did feel right inside about all that transgender stuff, but they were supposed to be the experts, right? I began seeing who Jesus really was, that He truly loved me, and HE WANTED to be with me.

I continued going to that church because I loved the people, and they were loving me. They weren't telling me, "Luca, it's time to stop dressing like a boy now." They just loved me, spent time with me, answered my questions about God.

The pastor preached the FULL GOSPEL: sin-all sorts of sin. homosexuality, sex outside marriage, strongholds. I didn't much like hearing it, but something in me said he was telling the truth. I didn't always believe him, so I bought a Bible to read it for myself, then began trusting him.

In 2012, three years after I started attending church, I knew it was time to leave my former life behind. I heard a scripture in church, "He who holds onto his life shall lose it, and he who loses it for My sake shall find it." I began my walk out of trauma and fear and was getting healed through the work of the Holy Spirit. Yes, I was water baptized and baptized in the Holy Spirit.

As I healed from the trauma, I began feeling safe to be female. At first it was terrifying, would this God hurt me? He let me get hurt as a child. But something kept telling me I'd be ok. The Lord—through several miracles—led me out of my home and out of that life.

MY TIME FOR FREEDOM!!! Through excellent discipleship, I learned to be the woman I was created to be. This is why it's important for us, the Church, to hear and obey the words of the Lord: "Go ye therefore, and make disciples, baptizing them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit."

that no prayer is too great or small for God to hear and answer according to His desire to love and bless you.



Abdi's Story— From Muslim to Christ

ecently, a team from Street Level Ministry went to a park in south Minneapolis. At one point, one of the members noticed a man sitting in the dark by himself. The team member felt prompted to talk to the man. He then observed the man reposition himself appearing as if he was staring at a church's cross across the street. The team member approached the man and handed him a Gospel tract, and a discussion began. The man, "Abdi" (we won't use his real name to protect him from his community), was amazed that the team member was telling him about Jesus - in fact, the moment before team member approached him, Abdi had just asked God to show him the truth, to give him a sign! When Abdi shared that, the team member light-heartedly said,

"I am your sign!". For some time before this, Abdi had been

questioning his faith in Islam.

He was struggling with how fear-based it was and seriously doubting it. So, Friday night he decided to go to the park away from his family to figure things out. (Friday evenings after sunset is a prayer time for Muslims). As he sat in that park bench, he was asking God, "Do I follow Buddha? Is it Muhammad? Is it Jesus? Please show me!" Then he looked across the street but it was not the lighted cross on the church building he looked at. It was a wooden telephone pole that had beams mounted at the top that made it look like Jesus's crucifixion. As he pondered that vision, that is the moment our team member approached Abdi.

After he shared that, Abdi continued to explain that the past couple of weeks he felt that God was giving him the numbers "333", and he did not know what that could mean.

Then team felt lead to share with Abdi the words from Jeremiah 33:3, "Call to Me and I will answer you, and I will tell you great and mighty things, which you do not know." Abdi and team were all very excited! Team member then explained the Gospel and Abdi put his faith in Christ - Hallelujah! Abdi and team exchanged contact information and gave Abdi some resources for follow-up. Please PRAY for Abdi!!! He is Somali and has now left Islam. Immediately, he was very concerned for his family's salvation and desperately wants them to know Jesus and be saved from Hell. PRAY for protection and strength against evil forces and resistance and persecution he most likely will face. PRAY for his family to receive his words about what happened. PRAY for successful follow-up and protection over everyone reaching out to him. This is the fruit of your prayers! We are so grateful!





Val and Mike's story — God's Plan

hat would be your response if a people in a middle-eastern country who you had given your allegiance to for the past 6 years, told you that you could never return nor could you get all your belongings, and say good-bye to a people you had grown to love? I Thess. 2:17

Many times, we don't see the short-term purpose nor the long-term advantage. When we look at the life of Joseph, we are looking back and seeing God's plan in using the life of Joseph with an expected end. As he stated in Genesis 50:20.

No, it probably didn't keep our fellow students of our school and Bible college alive, as in the case of Joseph, but it did protect my husband and myself from experiencing a prison sentence that we couldn't foresee in the future.

In the day-to-day tasks we were involved with we didn't see the imminent danger that was lurking behind the close doors and peeping eyes we were experiencing.

It was 2015, and my husband and I took on a ministry working with Iraqi and Syrian Refugees. All of them had registered with the U.N. so they could eventually be transferred to an English-speaking country. We decided an outreach to the people would be to teach them English and teach them the Gospel of John, vacation bible school and weekend gatherings.

Suddenly, the government told the refugees they must leave their apartments within 6 weeks and acquire a new one in a distant city. The Lord led us to continue teaching them in their new homes. There we established a school for the young people where they could continue their schooling in various subjects, along with daily devotionals. We also established a mini-Calvary Chapel Bible College and had evening English courses for

Syrian and Iraqi refugees. But things began to change as we began to experience opposition from our neighbors.

Turkish people really disdained this influx of refugees, (4 million), along with Americans renting in their cities. We were the only Americans living in this area and immediately, they began to complain there was too much noise and our landlord threatened to close us down. Secondly, during the evening classes we noticed those in the apartments facing us were taking pictures of us while teaching.

Our move caused red flags in the visa department. The department head was irate about our legal move and the work we were doing. He told our translator, "I will do everything in my power to keep these people from ever entering my country again."

Shortly after this, the Turkish military tried to

overthrow the president and take over the political situation. It was unsuccessful and thus everyone was looked upon very suspiciously, including us. We had to hide our school and studies for fear we would be noticed.

Shortly after this military coup, Mike was out sharing the gospel one day and was almost arrested in a Konya bus station. He was able to share with them the gospel before they released him.

We left the country in August, 2016, as Mike was doing an outreach for the Bible college students in Israel. Mike traveled on to Malta while my approach by airplane took me to Turkey and then transferring to another airport within Turkey. As I proceeded toward the airport passport control, I was told I could not enter the country. I was questioned many times and I proceeded to question them as to why I could not enter but with no avail.



Then the police came and took me to their holding area and I was told to wait for the next flight out. (Israel)

Looking back, we now see that if we continued in Turkey we could have been imprisoned as others. We were definitely on their radar since the "Military Coup" as later we found out that we were considered a "Security Threat" and as of now, we will never be allowed back into this country. We praise the Lord we are still able to connect with the people from Iraq with Bible studies so that their faith would continue to grow in grace, and encourage them concerning their faith. I Thess. 3:1-13

2005 to 2013

Judy Eckback took over the store management from 2005 – 2013. Judy also operated her book business, Inspirational Resources and was able to find many unique Christian jewelry pieces from Bob Seimon Design, Dicksons and Cross Jewelry. During this time, the Chapel was relocated in 2011 to its present location on Underwood next to the KidWay.





2014 to 2020

In 2014, Tom Curtis assumed the store responsibilities assisted by Liz Wieberg. Tom was a manager of a Northwestern Bookstore before LifeWay bought the chain.

Current

Liz Wiberg may look familiar to Chapel bookstore customers. Liz and her husband, Dean have been long-time volunteers. Liz has helped in the bookstore for many years before taking over the store in 2021. Welcome Liz!

he store product was increased by partnering with a local vendor, LifeWay Christian Stores as well as product from the ever popular Kerusso witness-wear t-shirts. In March, 2019 LifeWay Christian Store closed all its brick and mortar locations due to internet retail competition. The Chapel store lost one of its main suppliers but God knew and was

providentially preparing us for another product source—donated used items.

We put out a call to churches and individuals for donations of gently used Christian books, CDs, and movie DVDs. We were overwhelmed with the generosity of these items! During the fair, we sold thousands of donated items at a reduced rate. All sales from the bookstore were put

back into supporting the ministry.

As we continue to witness brick and mortar store locations closing, Crossroads continues to be committed to offering a 12 day, "hands-on" shopping experience during the fair. 

The Cross by Chris Heeb

n 2018, the Crossroads Chapel decided to construct & display an authentic first century Roman "Tau" cross. Other than the type of wood which was not available to us, we recreated a very credible replica which is approximately 400 pounds.

The Roman execution stake which Christians call the "Cross of Christ" is the most well-known symbol in History or as I like to say, HIS-story.

Starting about 2,200 years ago, it was the most intimidating symbol of Roman power and cruelty. The so-called Tau cross was named after the 19th letter of the Greek alphabet for T. The crosses were used for approximately 200 years before Christ and 300 years afterward. This was the Divine method God chose before the foundation of the World to deliver us from our Sins. This Tree-ology is the Gospel in part as spelled out in 1st Corinthians 15:1-4. Jesus brutal death on the Tree, His burial and HIS Resurrection would eventually deliver all of Creation from the curse in the Garden.


The TAU was a 2-piece cross. The vertical piece was in the 10-12 ft range and was buried 2-3 ft. The cross beam which our Lord carried was anywhere from 80-120 pounds. The Lord's cross also had a small wooden sign called a titlist, mentioned in John 19:19-20- "Roman Governor Pilate had a sign written out and put on the cross, reading Jesus of Nazareth, king of the Jews... and it was written in Hebrew, Greek and Latin".

In Genesis 2, God created ADAM, AW-DAM, the first man. He was named after the minerals/dust of the ground called Earth/AW-DAMA. Being direct physical descendants of our great uncle Adam,

the Apostle Paul makes it clear that all of Creation was bound up with Adam's Fall which had severe physical & spiritual consequences. Our bodies became cursed by disease and death, which was first brought into the world by Adam eating from the forbidden fruit of "the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil". From a human standpoint it seemed like all hope should have been lost! What was God's plan now? HIS plan all along was to send HIS second Adam!

The second Adam was Jesus, a Divine mixture of all man & God. He was designed to reverse the curse that the first Adam brought upon all of us when he disobeyed God's will in the Garden. The Tree's fruit had no power to destroy but it was breaking God's divine will that brought the punishment. God decided that the second Adam was going to undo the curse and redeem us through nailing him to another tree and that Tree was called the Cross of Calvary.

Jesus, also the Lamb of God (John 1:29) came to redeem us by being crucified on this symbolic Tree of Good and Evil. The Apostle Peter says, "Who his own self bore our sins in his own body on the Tree, that we being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes we were healed" (I Peter 2:24).

God nullified Satan's power over us that he had won in the Garden. Satan couldn't have imagined that the second tree, the Cross, would be his undoing.

Lastly in Revelation 22 in the New Jerusalem, the third tree, the Tree of Life will heal HIS people forever.

My name is Emilie and this is my New Life Story.

I was just a freshman in college, I was a high achiever with a plan for my life, which did not include getting pregnant. When I found out, I was in total shock. I told my parents and they were as shocked as I was, but also very supportive. They pointed me to New Life Family Services where I could go and discuss my options.

My first meeting at New Life sticks out to me because we spent a lot of time talking about how I was feeling, what I was thinking, and what I was concerned about. My time at New Life caused me to dig into what was going on in my head and heart: what I wanted, what I was scared about, what I imagined for my future and how my options fit into that.

The staff at New Life provided me with helpful information and long term goals to think about. I ultimately realized I wanted to raise my child and I knew I could do it because there was support available at New Life.

After I made my decision to parent, I enrolled in New Life's Parenting Education Program, Every Family, and attended once a week throughout my pregnancy. Through this program. I was able to learn about healthy development and met with Parenting Coaches who were genuinely interested in my life and how I was doing. This program helped me feel less anxious about becoming a mother and it also provided me with practical items, such as diapers and clothes for my baby.

Parenthood hasn't been without hardship, but the joys have far outweighed the hard days. Since having my son, Eli, I graduated from Every Family after two years in the program. I finished college with two degrees and I married the love of my life, a man who has been a part of Eli's life since he was four months old.



I am thankful for how much I have grown-both in maturity and in my relationship with God. Despite the darkness that has surrounded moments of my story, there is so much light.

It really is true. Every good and perfect gift is from above.

Facing each and new challenges

n Adult & Teen Challenge is a faithbased non-profit organization that began its journey over thirty years ago, starting from humble beginnings in a reclaimed crack house in Minneapolis. It has now grown to twelve campuses throughout the state, serving more than 4,000 clients each year.

At MnTC, our mission is to assist teens and adults in gaining freedom from chemical addictions and other life controlling problems by addressing their physical, emotional and spiritual needs. Today our programs range from telehealth and out-patient services, to residential licensed treatment, residential long-term recovery, and aftercare services. In addition to addressing substance use disorders, we provide co-occurring mental health services, offer a specialized Opioid addiction program, and provide trauma-informed care throughout our campuses.

Something that makes us unique is that we often provide care even for those without the ability to pay for services. We're able to do this thanks to generous support from church partners and individuals who come alongside us providing financial gifts. On average we raise \$1,453 per month for each client in our long-term recovery program. Research shows that 80% of those who graduate our program have the tools they need to not only stay sober, but to live fuller, happier lives. We thank God for this result.

Kallan's Story

My mom passed away when I was 5 years old, so I never really felt the love that only a mother can give. I began experimenting with alcohol and marijuana at age 13. I tried to fill the void in my life after losing my mom with independence, popularity and rebellion. In

high school, my dad was my principal, so I felt like I had to party harder than all of the other kids in order to prove myself. I started using prescription pills my freshman year of high school, which quickly led to trying heroin. I made one bad decision after another, constantly trying to feel better about myself and become numb to the lifestyle that I had created. After overdosing a number of times and watching my step-brother almost lose his life to an overdose, I realized I needed to make a change.

I came to Mn Adult & Teen Challenge in



2013. It took many months for my heart to finally soften and surrender to my need for Jesus. I'm thankful that Mn Adult & Teen Challenge gave me the tools and community I needed to find freedom. I still maintain friendships with both MnTC staff and other clients. Since graduating, I worked for MnTC for a time, which allowed me to share my story and grow my professional skills. I'm now married, working in sales and marketing for a local manufacturing company

In response to the growing need across Minnesota, we have expanded. We now have campuses in Minneapolis, Brainerd, Duluth, Rochester and Buffalo.

Kelly's Story

I started using as young girl dealing with abuse. When I began, I never realized my life would turn into an endless be search for

something to cover and mask the pain. I found myself in places I never thought I'd go because that's where the next high was. I lost my sons, my family and all of my friends and found myself homeless and living in my car. And then a pastor helped me get into MnTC.

Throughout my program, I dug into all of the hurt and guilt I had been holding onto, and with God's grace I was able to forgive myself. After graduating I have been blessed to find restoration with all three of my sons. I've been part of weddings, and have been by their sides through the happiest times of their lives. I've also been able to give back by working for MnTC for 9 years; I've just been promoted to a Lead Recovery Coach Coordinator. I've also been blessed with my 6th grandchild, with a 7th on the way. The best part is, none of my grandchildren know me as an addict but only as the praying Nana that loves them.

For everyone 2020 has been a year of unplanned surprises. As a Minneapolis non-profit, we've had to adapt to the pandemic and to the riots that occurred in our backyard. While there have been many uncertain moments, we continue to see God at work and trust in His plan. When looters and rioters were in the streets to cause chaos, the community around us came together and protected our buildings from destruction.

The need for our services has never been greater. It is because of the community around us that we have survived, grown, and can help more people than ever. Because of you, our supporters, lives are being transformed, families are being restored, and communities are being strengthened.
